**Weigh-in will be Tuesday, 9:00 a.m., during check-in, for ALL barrows and crossbred gilts including Junior Auction  
barrows.**

**Entry forms must be postmarked no later than June 22, 2018. Walk-in entry forms no later than June 25, 2018, at the  
Fairground Office.**

**\*\*\*\*NO entries will be taken past the deadline and entry fees MUST be paid 24 hours prior to the show time. There  
will be no changes on day of the show. NO EXCEPTIONS.**

**PREMIUM CHECKS WILL NOT BE ISSUED WITHOUT EXHIBITORS SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER- NO EXCEPTIONS.  
REGISTRATION PAPERS REQUIRED ON ALL PUREBRED LIVESTOCK AND MUST BE IN EXHIBITOR'S NAME.  
REGISTRATION PAPERS TO BE AVAILABLE FOR CHECK 24 HOURS PRIOR TO SHOW. (See General Rules)**

**Specific Department Rules:**

- All livestock exhibitors are required to purchase an exhibitor pass for \$5.00. Other exhibitors may purchase a pass if they feel it is necessary. You must be an exhibitor at the fair to purchase a pass. Exhibitors passes will get only the exhibitor into the front gate.
- **4-H Show will begin at 8:00 A.M. with the open show following**
- Barrows will be weighed 9 AM Tuesday, crossbred gilts will be weighed and divided into 3 classes the night prior to the show.
- State number of pens with entry.
- No straw allowed. Sawdust bedding available at no charge.
- We reserve the right to combine classes if there is only one exhibitor in a class.
- All hogs must be on grounds by 9:00 a.m. Tuesday, June 26 to show, and will be released Friday, June 29 at 9:00 a.m.
- All wire, cans, bottles, and garbage shall be placed in containers. All show boxes, feed and cots must be kept in area of individual stalls and out of show ring.
- All effective dates are year 2018.
- At the conclusion of the open/junior swine show there will be 2 showmanship classes (ages 8-13 and 14-19). Trophies will be donated by the Mike Hemann family and \$50 cash prize will be donated from the Bob Thompson Memorial fund.
