Specific Department Rules:

- All livestock exhibitors are required to purchase an exhibitors pass for \$5.00. Other exhibitors may purchase a pass if they feel it is necessary. You must be an exhibitor at the fair to purchase a pass. Exhibitors passes will get only the exhibitor into the front gate.
- All exhibits must be brought to ART HALL on Tuesday evening, June 26, 6:00- 8:00 p.m. or before 9:00 a.m. on Wednesday, June 27. Judging will be held Wednesday, June 27 at 9:00 a.m.
- All entries to be judged on workmanship, technique, naturalness, originality and color.
- Two year premium limit on blue ribbon winners
- Same entry cannot win trophy more than once
- One entry per category per person.
- Entries not in proper category will be disqualified.
