Entry forms must be postmarked no later than June 23, 2018. Walk-in entries received no later than June 27, 2018 at the Fairgrounds Office.

PREMIUM CHECKS WILL NOT BE ISSUED WITHOUT EXHIBITORS SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER. NO EXCEPTIONS. REGISTRATION PAPERS REQUIRED ON ALL PUREBRED LIVESTOCK. REGISTRATION PAPERS MUST BE IN EXHIBITOR'S NAME, AND CHECKED AS PER STATE REQUIREMENTS. (See general rules)

Specific Department Rules:

- All livestock exhibitors are required to purchase an exhibitors pass for \$5.00. Other exhibitors may purchase a pass if they feel it is necessary. You must be an exhibitor at the fair to purchase a pass. Exhibitors passes will get only the exhibitor into the front gate.
- No cattle or tack allowed in barns prior to 1 pm Tuesday, June 26
- All animals to be on grounds by 8:00 a.m., Wednesday, June 27, released Saturday, June 30 at 8:00 a.m. Steer will be weighed and mouthed, Thursday, June 28. Steers may be mouthed in accordance with State Fair rules. STEERS SHOWN BY BREEDS
- All animals showing in group classes must show in single class. We reserve the right to combine classes if there is only one exhibitor in a class.
- All animals must be tattooed and registered in respective breeds, including animals entered in "All Other Breeds".
- All animals must be stalled in the barns
- All breeding cattle must be at least 50% of stated breed or shown in all other breeds. State Fair guidelines will be followed for steers and breeding cattle as per registration show requirements and percentages.
- All exhibitors must present premise ID number at time of entry.
- **Generators allowed in approved areas only.**
- Points Show: IBA rules will be followed.
- All ethics rules will follow state fair guidelines.
- No chute in Hog Barn.
- All wire, cans, bottles, and **garbage** shall be placed in containers. All show boxes, feed and cots must be kept in area of individual stalls and out of show ring.
